Water Deposit – We require a water, sewer, and garbage deposit of \$175.00 payable upon move-in-or purchase of property. You may drop the deposit money off at the city office, located at the west end of Main Street, you may mail it to the above address or you may drop it in the drop box located at the office on Main Street. All water bill payments may be made in the same manner. The deposit is retained indefinitely but will be applied to your final water bill should you move.

Fees for water, sewer and garbage are as follows: Flat Water Rate: \$30/month plus water use billed at \$1.50 per 1,000 gallons used, based on your water meter reading; Flat Sewer Rate: \$12/month plus sewer use fee at \$1.50 cents per 1,000 gallons based on March water reading; Garbage: \$10.00 month – 1 person; \$12.50/month – 2 people, \$14.50/month – family. Commercial rates vary, for more information please contact me at the above number.

Garbage pickup: North of Main Street – Monday mornings

South of Main Street – Thursday mornings

Please place trash by curb in front of your house. Garbage Service is provided by Bud's Sanitation, Newman Grove – (402) 447-6472.

The City Council meets on the 3rd Monday at 7:00 pm at the Community Center. If you would like to be put on the agenda for any reason, please call the City office by the 2nd Thursday of the month.

Building permits - Any type of property improvement requires a building permit. The permit must be submitted to the City Clerk by 10:00 am the first Wednesday of the month so that it may be published and heard at the regular monthly city council meeting. Any permits turned in after the deadline publishing date will be heard at the next city council meeting. To obtain a permit form, please contact the city office.

Dog Licensing - all dogs are required to have a pet license. Proof of rabies must be submitted to the City office within two weeks of moving to town. Costs are: \$10.00 per male and spayed female \$20- for female dog. Limit to three dogs per household.
